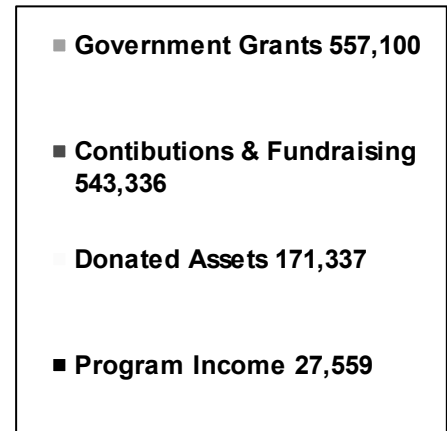
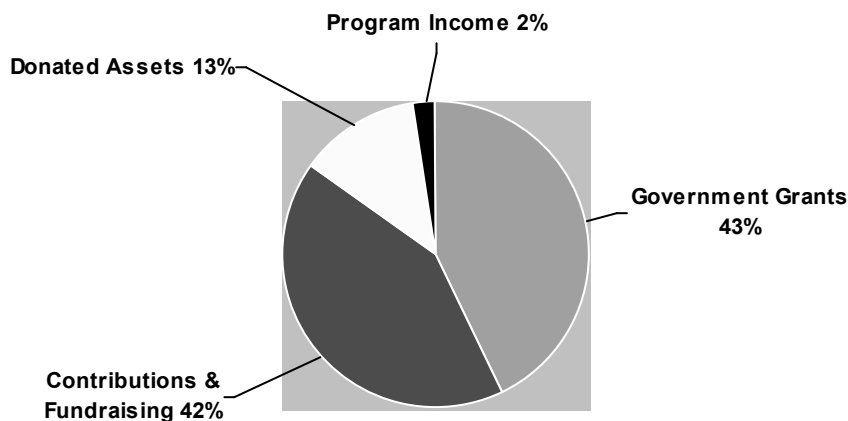
We Are Proud of Our Efficiency

As a contributor to the *Jeanne Geiger CRISIS CENTER*, you can also be proud of being part of an organization that is working hard to ending family violence.

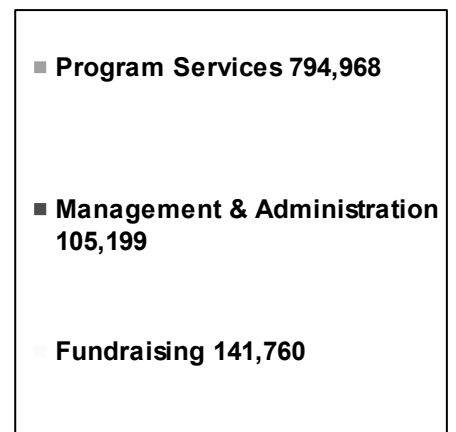
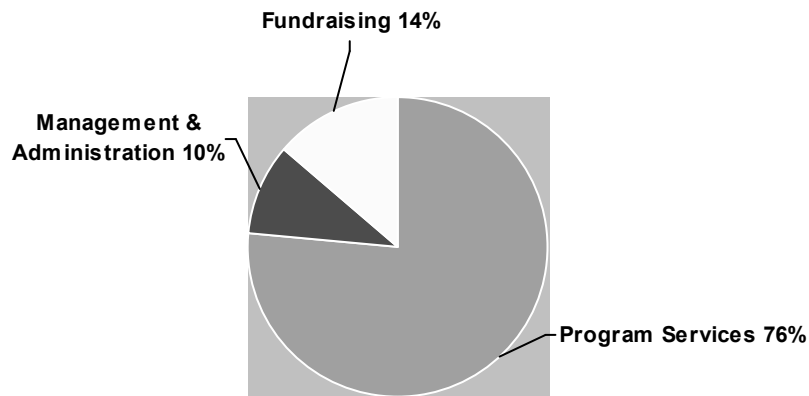

Annual Report

July 1, 2004 – June 30, 2005

Frederick Buechner wrote, *“The life I touch for good or ill will touch another life, and that in turn another, until who knows where the trembling stops or in what far place my touch will be felt.”*

The mission of the *Jeanne Geiger CRISIS CENTER* is to empower members of our community to live free from fear, intimidation, violence, or the threat of abuse by providing support, advocacy, and education.

We envision a culture in which domestic violence and abusive behavior are not tolerated.

Statistics

- 1140 adults (97% female), 86 children
- 37% of our clients came from Amesbury, 23% of our clients came from Newburyport, and 22% of our clients came from Salisbury
- 10% increase in demand for community based services
- 100% increase in calls requesting shelter from last year
- We answered 3216 hotline calls

Agency Highlights

- Julian R. Geiger and the Geiger Family 1999 Irrevocable GST Trust made a donation to the Center to honor the memory of Jeanne Geiger, a supporter who passed away in February 2005.
- We changed the name of the organization from the Women’s Crisis Center to the *Jeanne Geiger CRISIS CENTER* on June 25th
- We have a new website – www.jeannegeigercrisiscenter.org

Program Highlights

- Formation and implementation of the High Risk Team that works to reduce violence re-assaults and homicides. The team is a multi-disciplinary group comprised of the police departments of Amesbury, Newbury, Newburyport, and Salisbury; the probation office of the Newburyport District Court; and Doug Gaudette from Caritas Holy Family Hospital.
- Co-sponsored a conference with Harvard Law School entitled, *“Increasing the Capacity of the Criminal Justice System to Respond to Intimate Partner Violence”*
- Participated in ongoing legislative hearings about legislation that calls for monitoring high risk batterers using GPS technology
- Developed a speakers bureau of client speakers
- Presented four conferences to Massachusetts probation officers called “Voices of Victims”
